Offer impartial and confidential information, SEND advice and support to parent/carers, children and young people 0-25 years which enables our service users to make their OWN decisions and choices.



We Signpost to:

Local sources of information, advice and support including the SEND Local Offer

National sources of information, advice and support including IPSEA

Support Parents with resources such as guides, support groups and events.

Our aim is to enable our service users to participate independently in meetings following our input. However, attending meetings is part of the service that we offer when it is necessary.

Help CYP, families and partners we work with understand statutory SEND processes, for example, EHC assessment and planning, timescales, how to check draft plans, understanding what to do when unhappy with a draft EHCP, how naming a school works and parental preference

Statutory work, which may lead to an Education Health and Care
Plan (EHCP) and beyond.

Concerns from the earliest stages of getting help.
SEN Support from early years to post-19.
Ways of accessing services to support education.
